# Updates

**HIStory of Christmas** was very successful this year in several ways. The Duncansville Evangelical Lutheran Church organizers designated the parlor of the church as the Brian Morden Foundation room.

During the 5 afternoons and evenings of HIStory, more than 500 people had a chance to see and hear what the Brian Morden Foundation does in the



fight against childhood cancer. Information in our presentation included:

- ♥ Since 2003, the BMF has helped more than 35 local children with cancer and their families. We provide gas cards for transportation to and from treatment, gifts, cards and/or coupons during each of the major holidays and the children's birthdays.
- We also send Brian Baskets filled with a variety

of gifts and treats to help make a stay in the hospital or clinic go a little better and more quickly. These items are for the pediatric oncology patients, their families, and staff at four Pennsylvania Children's Hospitals -Pittsburgh, Hershey, Geisinger, and **Philadelphia – during** the major holidays (Christmas, Valentine's Day, Easter, Fourth of July, Halloween, and



Thanksgiving) Some of the items have included laptops, iPads, PlayStations, Issy and Tickles bears, Brian Blankets and prayer shawls.

♥ Donations of more than \$88,000 to cancer researchers in Utah, Michigan, California, Johns Hopkins, CureSearch in honor of all of our children fighting cancer and Be The Match in memory of Tim Piper. ♥ Higher education scholarships totaling \$35,000 have been donated to local students as well as cancer survivors.

Through the generosity of many, the Brian Morden Foundation received donations totaling \$989. In addition, BMF merchandise including greeting cards, chocolate covered pretzels, ornaments, t-shirts, and Issy bears was sold. With more than a total of \$1700 from HIStory of Christmas, the BMF will continue the fight against childhood cancer.
